One Pager

A one-pager is a way of responding to a piece of media by using a single sheet of paper. It represents your own written and graphic interpretation of what you have read, heard, or watched. It may be very literal (just based on the facts or information in the piece) or it may be a symbolic representation of the piece.

Directions:

- Must be on a standard sized, unlined paper
- Must fill the entire page
- Writing must be neat and in ink or marker...no pencil
- Include the title and author
- Use colored pencils or markers

Required Elements:

1. Must contain an inference with text support about one of the following elements from the book so far:
 - Setting
 - Conflict
 - Characterization
2. Must have two lines from the text that support your inference
3. Must have a graphic representation that ties to the lines you've chosen from the text and supports your inference
